



## 2022 Election to the Elysian Board of Trustees

Three-year term: 2022-2025

### You can make a difference.

The Elysian Board of Trustees invites you to consider running for one of the available openings on the Board. Or you may know someone outside our community who would be a great candidate. The Board is looking for motivated individuals with a passion for education and the mission of Elysian to bring their perspectives and talents to the governance of the school.

The Board of Trustees is the governing body which oversees school policy and its budget. It consists of 9 members, of which 3 are elected every year for a 3-year term. Trustees meet monthly to review school business and participate throughout in committees focused on specialized areas of the school (e.g., finance, facilities, academics, etc.).

### Nominations and Election Process

Potential candidates should express interest by requesting a **nominee packet** from Deb Rosner in the school office. Candidates will be required to complete the documentation and prepare a brief biographical statement introducing themselves to the community and why they are running. New board members will then be elected from among the candidates at the Annual Meeting, which will be held on Wednesday, March 9, 2022 at 6:00- 7:00 pm.

- **Nominee Packets** will be available between **Friday, January 28<sup>th</sup> 2022** and **Friday, February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022**.
- **Request a nominee packet** electronically via email from Deb Rosner at [deb.rosner@ecsnj.org](mailto:deb.rosner@ecsnj.org).
- **Deadline for submission:** All completed nominee packets must be received by the end of the school day on **February 11, 2022** to be considered eligible for the election at the Annual Meeting.

The Board is looking for talented individuals who are willing and able to give their time and energy to supporting our children and our community. Successful Board members do not need to be parents of Elysian children, and may have various professional backgrounds. Those with strong connections to other educational institutions in our area would be welcome. The Board strongly encourages individuals from historically underrepresented communities to apply.
